ASSESSMENT/INTERVENTIONS:

LTBI

- All clients with a positive Mantoux test must be assessed for signs and symptoms of active TB. Please check (√) all that apply:

asymptomatic

symptomatic ⇨ cough fever weight loss fatigue night sweats

- A chest x-ray must be done for all clients with a positive Mantoux test.
- Latent TB infection (LTBI) is diagnosed when the client with a positive Mantoux test has a negative chest x-ray and is asymptomatic. This must be reported within 7 days.

ACTIVE TB

Follow-up for Active TB:

- Suspect pulmonary TB, per chest x-ray report or signs and symptoms, would need to have **three** sputum samples collected 24 hours apart.
- Suspected or confirmed TB must be reported within 24 hours.
